Fee: \$35 pre-registration only (plus \$2.00 registration fee). **NO WALK INS!**

Weight Classes: Madison Weights

Format: 3-5 Man Round-Robin - Scholastic Rules - Periods 1, 1, 1, and overtime, if necessary. Head gear a must. Exhibition matches can be arranged.

Awards: 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Place Medals

Concession: Food and beverages will be available all day

Registration: Tournament will be limited to the first 300 wrestlers to register. Clubs should register as early as possible and if need be, submit weigh-ins at a later date. **Registration is online only at** <https://events.flowrestling.org/event/0cc74b26-8a86-9596-9a75-9e4a29f1616e>

Registration closes at **8 PM** on **Nov 29, 2019.**

- **Wrestlers MUST have a 2019-20 USA Wrestling Card** (available at <http://www.usawmembership.com>). Cards NOT sold day of tourney. Wrestlers MUST be able to produce USAW Card at check-in.
- All coaches must have a valid 2019-20 USAW Coaches Card to be allowed on the mats. (Security personnel will be posted mat-side and this policy will be *strictly enforced!*)
- All wrestlers must have proof of age with them in case an age is challenged.
- Emergency Medical Personnel will be on site.
- No refunds will be given.

Additional Tournament Information

1. The tournament will be run a FLOWRESTLING at <http://arena.flowrestling.org>. All brackets, match scoring and mat assignments will be available online after weigh-ins are complete.
2. Weight classes will be assigned to the same mat for the entire session.
3. All bouts on a bracket will have a bout number. The bout numbers will be based on the mat assignment. Mat 1 will start at 101, mat 2 will start at 201, etc.
4. Bouts will be assigned to each mat in bout order. If your wrestler is assigned bout numbers 101, 106 and 111, then he/she will be the 1st, 6th and 11th match on Mat 1.
5. A **Bout Display** area will be available to show mat assignments and bout queues on each mat
